

Family Pentecost Novena Day 7 – Thursday May 20

Proclamation: God the Father and Jesus the Son live in a constant exchange of love. This love is the person of the Holy Spirit. Jesus keeps his promise to love me with the Father's love by sending the Holy Spirit to live in me.

Scripture: John 17:22, 24-26 *excerpt from the Gospel Reading of today's Mass*

"I have given them the glory you gave me Father, they are your gift to me. I wish that where I am they also may be with me, that they may see my glory that you gave me, because you loved me before the foundation of the world. Righteous Father . . . I made known to them your name and I will make it known, that the love with which you loved me may be in them and I in them."
