

Family Pentecost Novena Day 6 – Wednesday June 1

Proclamation: Jesus gave his whole life to do all that the Father asked of him. Now Jesus calls me to do the same. He sends the Holy Spirit so that I can be “consecrated in truth.”

Scripture: John 17:17-19 *excerpt from the Gospel Reading of today’s Mass*

“Holy Father . . . consecrate them in the truth. Your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, so I sent them into the world. And I consecrate myself for them, so that they also may be consecrated in truth.”

Praise and Prayer:

“Awesome in his sanctuary is God, the God of Israel; he gives power and strength to his people.” *from responsorial psalm, Psalm 68*

Heavenly Father, you are an awesome God! I thank you for giving me the power and strength to do your will.

Symbols of the Holy Spirit: The Seal



A seal, called sphragis in Greek, was used in ancient times to mark one’s name or symbol on a letter or other important object. When a person is baptized or confirmed he receives the “seal” of the Holy Spirit to show that he belongs to God.
