Proclamation: The Apostles and first disciples were eye-witnesses of all that Jesus said and did. And they were there on Pentecost when the Holy Spirit came. They wrote down what they saw and heard. I can read this exciting story in the Bible for myself and the Holy Spirit will help me to be like an eye-witness too.

Scripture: John 21:24-25 *excerpt from the Gospel Reading of today's Mass*

This is from the end of St. John's Gospel. We have been reading this Gospel all through the Easter Season. Here John is speaking of himself as an eye-witness to all that Jesus said and did.

"It is this disciple who testifies to these things and has written them, and we know that his testimony is true. There are also many other things that Jesus did, but if these were to be described individually, I do not think the whole world would contain the books that would be written."
