Proclamation: Jesus called St. Peter to be our first Pope and commanded him to care for all of God's people, his "sheep". Jesus calls me to follow him too. He sends me the Holy Spirit so that I can be a faithful disciple.

Scripture: John 21:15-17, 19b excerpt from the Gospel Reading of today's Mass

When they had finished breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." He said to him, "Feed my lambs." He then said to him a second time, "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" He said to him, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." He said to him, "Tend my sheep." He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" Peter was distressed that he had said to him a third time, "Do you love me?" and he said to him, "Lord, you know everything; you know that I love you." Jesus said to him, "Feed my sheep.... And when Jesus had said this, he said to Peter, "Follow me."
