- Solemnity of the Anniversary of the Dedication of Christ the King Church, 11:00 Mass
- Solemnity of the Assumption, 7:00 Mass*
- Solemnity of All Saints, 7:00 Mass*
- Solemnity of Christ the King, 11:00 Mass
- Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, 7:00 Mass
- Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord, 8:00pm Mass
